

What is the Summer Stock Exchange?



The Summer Stock Exchange is a small, library run Stock Market Simulation for tweens and teens ages 9-18. It operates from 10am-12pm on Tuesdays and 2pm-4pm on Fridays, during which time tweens and teens can buy or sell stocks using chocolate coins.



What is the purpose?

The purpose of the Summer Stock
Exchange is to teach the basics of how the
Stock Market works. Tweens and teens will
learn beginner terminology and how different
events can affect the price of a stock.

How does it work?



Each participant will be given a basket containing five chocolate coins. During market hours, they may use their coins to buy and sell stocks to try and earn more coins. At the end of the Summer Stock Exchange, all owned stocks will be cashed out for coins and participants will receive everything in their basket.



Why come to all the sessions?

Each time the Summer Stock Exchange is open, participants will receive a different set of news that affects the price of their stocks. Attendance at every session is not required, but is encouraged to receive the full experience.
